USEFULL INFORMATION

What is a day residence?

A day residence is a virtual residence that functions like any university residence. The main difference is that a virtual residence has no physical building where the residents reside.

Why join a day residence?

Student life initiatives can only be successful if the entire student population actively participates in organized student activities. A day residence allows you to participate and join any campus initiative as a normal residence student.

Who is in charge of the day residence?

All residences on campus are managed by a house committee that consists of elected students and a houseparent. A house committee is an elected committee that represents students of the residence and implement and coordinate student life activities. A house parent is a staff member who is appointed to oversee activities within residence and to ensure together with the house committee that all activities are planned and implemented within the policies, regulations and values of the university.

Will a day residence cost me anything?

Yes. A day residence do charge a levy of R130 per year. The levy is debited from the student's account.

What do I get for my R130?

Besides the opportunity to meet some of your future friends, the levy also includes participation in a range of subsidized residence activities, logistical assistance for student life activities and all other benefits associated with the effective operations of a residence.
