Key requirements:

Certified copy of South African ID (by birth)

Proof of Gauteng residence

Matric certificate (certified)

Proof of income from parent/s or guardian/s or affidavit

Letter of motivation (not more than 2 pages)

Proof of registration or acceptance letter from PSET institution

Any relevant affidavit

Disability/ medical report (where appropriate)
