ABOUT THE COMPANY – KYB

Kitso Ya Boleng is a non-profit company and is proudly supported by the Boleng Trust. The Trust is an Assore Limited (mining holding company principally engaged in ventures involving base minerals and metals) initiative that was established for the benefit of Historically Disadvantaged South Africans (HDSAs) and broad-based HDSA community groupings residing in the areas in which the Assore group's mines and beneficiation plants are located.

ABOUT THE ALSE BURSARY PROGRAMME

The ALSE programme was started in Potchefstroom this year (2020) and aims to provide additional learning and support to learners who wish to follow a career in teaching, specifically the North West University B.Ed. Senior Phase and FET teaching degree. The ALSE Bursary Programme awards limited bursaries to South African financially disadvantaged black males and females with strong academic records. **Only students who have already applied and who have been accepted at North West University for the above degree with (pure) Mathematics and Physical Science as their primary teaching subjects, will be considered for the bursary.**

MORE ABOUT THE BURSARY PROGRAMME – COVERAGE VALUE & SELECTION

The bursary will provide coverage for the following expenses: tuition fees, prescribed textbooks, accommodation, and an allowance for general living expenses. Recipients of the bursary will be required to teach at a public school for the same number of years that they receive the bursary.

Bursaries will be awarded to the following qualification only:

Undergraduate studies:

North West University Bachelor of Education degree (4 year B.Ed): specialising in Senior Phase (Grade 7-9) and FET Phase (Grade 10-12) with primary subject choice (pure) Mathematics and Physical Sciences.

Only candidates that have already been accepted at NWU for the above degree and primary teaching subjects will be considered. The eligibility requirements below also apply.

Shortlisted candidates will be contacted and required to attend an academic and personality assessment, and an interview with the KYB Management team. If you have not received any feedback regarding your application within 2 weeks of submission, please regard your application as unsuccessful.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must satisfy the following minimum entry criteria before applying (please note that failure to satisfy all the requirements will lead to your application not being considered):

- South African citizen
- Black male and female students
- Currently in Matric OR have completed Matric
- 21 years old or younger if applying for the first time
- Have NOT completed another teaching qualification
- Full acceptance to study at North West University in 2021
- Full acceptance to the NWU B.Ed. Degree for Senior Phase and FET
- Full acceptance to teach Mathematics and Physical Science as primary teaching subjects
- Financially disadvantaged
- Have a strong academic record
- Clear criminal record
- *Preference will be given to applicants in rural areas and applicants who intend to teach in rural areas

- Proof of application status at North West University, North West Province, South Africa
- Motivational letter explaining why you deserve the bursary and how it will make a difference to your life
- Curriculum Vitae
