### Step 1

### Step 4

Remember your face mask and proof of registration.

You will be screened at the Campus gate by a Protection Services Officer



### Step 6

Proceed to your relevant University Residence. You can find your way using the Campus map available in the Orientation programme.



### Step 7

Sign-in when you arrive at your University Residence, where after you will be allocated a room and receive your keys.



### Step 8

Get to know your House Parent, Residence Officer and House Committee, as they will assist you in adjusting to University Life in the coming weeks.
