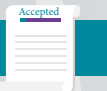
NSFAS Student

NSFAS student is a student who applied and has been approved to receive funding from the National Student Financial Aid Scheme (NSFAS) to pursue their studies at a University in 2023.

****Note that the following steps are subject to change.**

Step 1

Admission to the NWU.



Step 3

Wait for Student Finances to confirm your financial clearance via SMS.



Step 5

Capture your banking details via the NWU DIY App. Student Finances will inform you about the private accommodation arrangements



Conditional Registration

A conditionally registered student has not met the prescribed financial requirements to complete their registration - this is automatically indicated by the Varsite Student System (VSS).

You can go from a conditionally registered student to a registered student by:

1. paying the outstanding first minimum payment in full; or
2. making an arrangement with the NWU to settle the outstanding minimum payment; or
3. NSFAS confirming your NSFAS approval.

Non-NSFAS Bursary Holders and Loan Funded Students

Students funded by a bursary provider other than NSFAS, or by means of a loan obtained from a financial institution.

Step 1

Admission to the NWU.

Step 3

Your finances will be cleared according to the amount of your bursary/loan.

Step 5

Register via the NWU Registration Portal.

Step 2

Submit the Proof of Bursary/Loan to:

Step 4

Your financial clearance will be confirmed via an SMS from Student Finance.

Cash-paying Students

Students who pay for their study fees "out-of-pocket" and do not have an external bursary or loan to fund their studies.

Step 1

Admission to the NWU.

Step 3

Register via the NWU Registration Portal.

Step 2

Pay the minimum payable amount(s) as indicated in Fees Payable and Financial Rules Booklet.

Step 4

Visit Orientation Programme Website.

NB: Pay the minimum payable amount 48 hours before you want to register!
