

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS FOR VOTING DURING THE 2025/2026 SCC AND SRC: DSO ELECTION

	QUESTION	ANSWER
1.	WHERE will I be able to vote?	Voting will be conducted ONLINE on the Question Pro platform. Each student voter will receive an email with a link to their campus' voting site .
2.	HOW will I access the voting site?	A personalised email with your student number and unique password will be sent to your studentnumber@mynwu.ac.za email address. You will use your student number and the unique password to access the voting site. This is <u>not</u> your eFundi password.
3.	WHEN will I receive the email with my password and voting site link?	The links to the voting sites, student numbers and unique passwords will be circulated to student voters on 15 August 2025 between 08:00-14:00. These emails will be distributed per campus in numerical order.
4.	Can SOMEONE ELSE VOTE on my behalf, or can I vote on their behalf?	NO! No student voter, candidate or student support group may vote for you, or on behalf of you. This is against the rules.
5.	Should I SHARE my student number and unique password with someone else?	NO! You are not allowed to share your student number and password combination with another student. This is against the rules.
6.	Can I HELP other students to vote?	Students who struggle to cast their votes must contact the ISEC or their CECT. It is against the rules to setup a voter station or provide devices for other students to vote, regardless of whether this occurs on or off campus.
7.	Which EMAIL ADDRESS will the NWU use to communicate with me on election related information?	The NWU will only use your studentnumber@mynwu.ac.za to communicate election related information. No Gmail, Yahoo, iCloud, or other "private" email addresses will be used.
8.	Will I receive SMS's relating to the SCC and SRC:DSO elections?	Yes, the NWU may send you an SMS on the electoral processes, but this will be limited to announcements on information published on the <i>NWU Student Leadership Elections 2025</i> webpage, click here .
9.	How many TIMES will I be able to VOTE ?	Each student voter can only vote ONCE (one time) This means, once you have cast all your votes and clicked "Submit your votes", you will not be able to vote again.
10.	What should I do if I DO NOT want to VOTE for a specific SCC portfolio?	If you do not want to vote for a specific portfolio, you must select the "Abstain" option. This vote will not count towards any candidate.
11.	Should I go to eFundi to access voting materials?	No! All election related information is published on the <i>NWU Student Leadership Elections 2025</i> webpage, click here .
12.	How do I know what will happen NEXT in the electoral process?	Refer to the 2025 Election Schedule for the SCCs and SRC: DSO published on the <i>NWU Student Leadership Elections 2025</i> webpage, click here .
13.	Who is ELIGIBLE for election to the SCC or SRC: DSO?	Refer to the list of candidates published on the <i>NWU Student Leadership Elections 2025</i> webpage, click here .
14.	I have an OBJECTION or COMPLAINT , what do I do?	All objections and complaints relating to the electoral process must be directed to the Independent Students' Election Commission (ISEC) in writing via the email address: isec@nwu.ac.za .
15.	Will I receive a CONFIRMATION EMAIL or SMS once I have submitted my votes?	NO, you will not receive a confirmation email or SMS. However, a final notification page will display after you have clicked "Submit your votes" indicating that you have completed your voting opportunity.
