



Application Checklist:

Here is what you need to apply!



1. Choose your study options



Choose your **two (2) preferred study options** and research their admission requirements. Ensure you meet these requirements but note that meeting the minimum criteria does not guarantee acceptance to NWU.

Admission requirements, including **APS** and **subject requirements**, may vary depending on the qualification you choose. Some programmes may require a higher APS score or additional subject requirements.

2. Have your own valid email address



- Create or use your own active email address (for example, **Gmail**). Do not use a parent's, friend's, or school email address. Each applicant may use only one email address.
- Choose a password that is secure but easy to remember, for example: **MyNWU2026!**
- Make sure you know and keep your email password safe, as NWU will send important updates and application information to this email address.

3. Prepare your documents



- Keep your ID document or passport (for international students) ready in digital format (PDF or JPEG). Please note that a birth certificate cannot be used to apply.
- Also ensure your final Grade 11 or Grade 12 results are available in digital format.

4. Administration fee



- A non-refundable administration fee of **R150.00** for prospective students (South African citizens) is applicable.
- A non-refundable administration fee of **R600.00** is applicable for international applicants.
