
1 When to complete the form

- The Financial Undertaking Form will be provided when you receive a conditional offer from NWU.
- Download the interactive form and fill it out digitally.

2) Fill out your personal information

Please note: The Financial Undertaking Form cannot be signed online. You must download the document first, then sign it manually before uploading it to your application profile.

- South African ID Number of student: At the top of the form, South African citizens must enter their 13-digit South African ID number, as shown on their ID card.
- Non-South African residents should enter their foreign/ Non-South African ID or Study Permit number in the indicated section.



3 Completing the parent/guardian details

- At the bottom of the form, there is a section for your **parent**, **guardian**, or the person taking financial responsibility for your education.
- Ensure their full name, signature, 13-digit ID number, and address are filled out accurately

4 Review and upload

After completing the form, **carefully review** all the details to ensure they are accurate.

To ensure that you upload the correct document to the student application portal, please name the file

"Financial_Undertaking_Form_Your name and application number". For example, "Lebo Mokoena _ APP2026-123456".

This will help you easily identify and upload the correct form, avoiding any confusion or errors during the submission process.

Upload the completed form to the **application portal** under the **Documents section.**

What to Do if Your Financial Undertaking Form is Rejected

In rare cases, the Financial Undertaking Form may be rejected due to various reasons:

- Incorrect or invalid ID number.
- When the Financial Undertaking Form is signed digitally. It must be downloaded, signed manually, and then uploaded to your application profile.

- **Inaccurate details** or **signature** that seems inauthentic.
- **Form errors** such as missing information or incorrect formats.

If this happens:

- Carefully read the reasons for the rejection provided by the system.
- Log in to the application portal, go to the Documents section, and download a new copy of the Financial Undertaking Form.
- Fill out the form **correctly** and **resubmit** it.

Important Reminder: Your **final offer** from NWU will only be accepted once the **Financial Undertaking Form** has been completed, submitted, and accepted by the Student Finance Department. Ensure that all details are accurate to avoid delays in your admission process.
