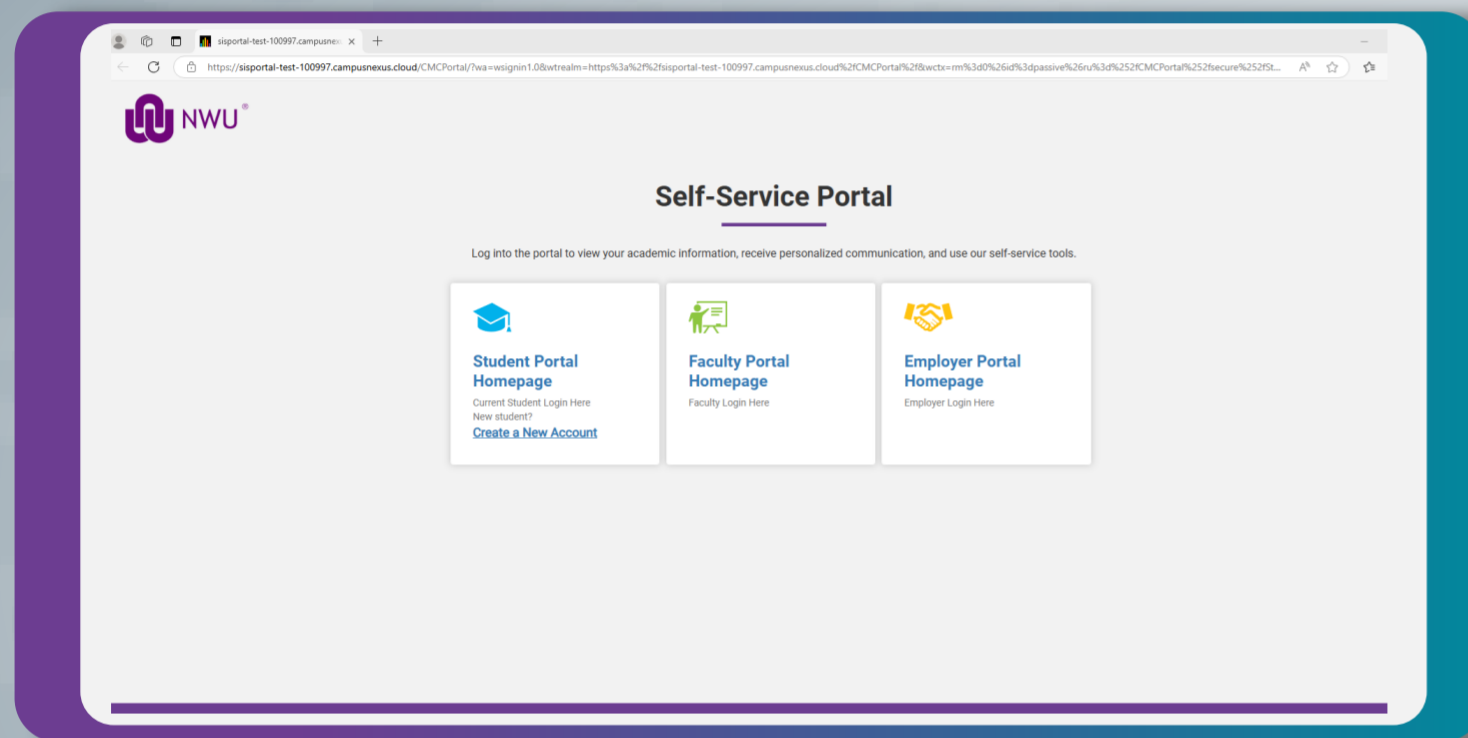


Simplify your university journey with the Student Engagement Portal!

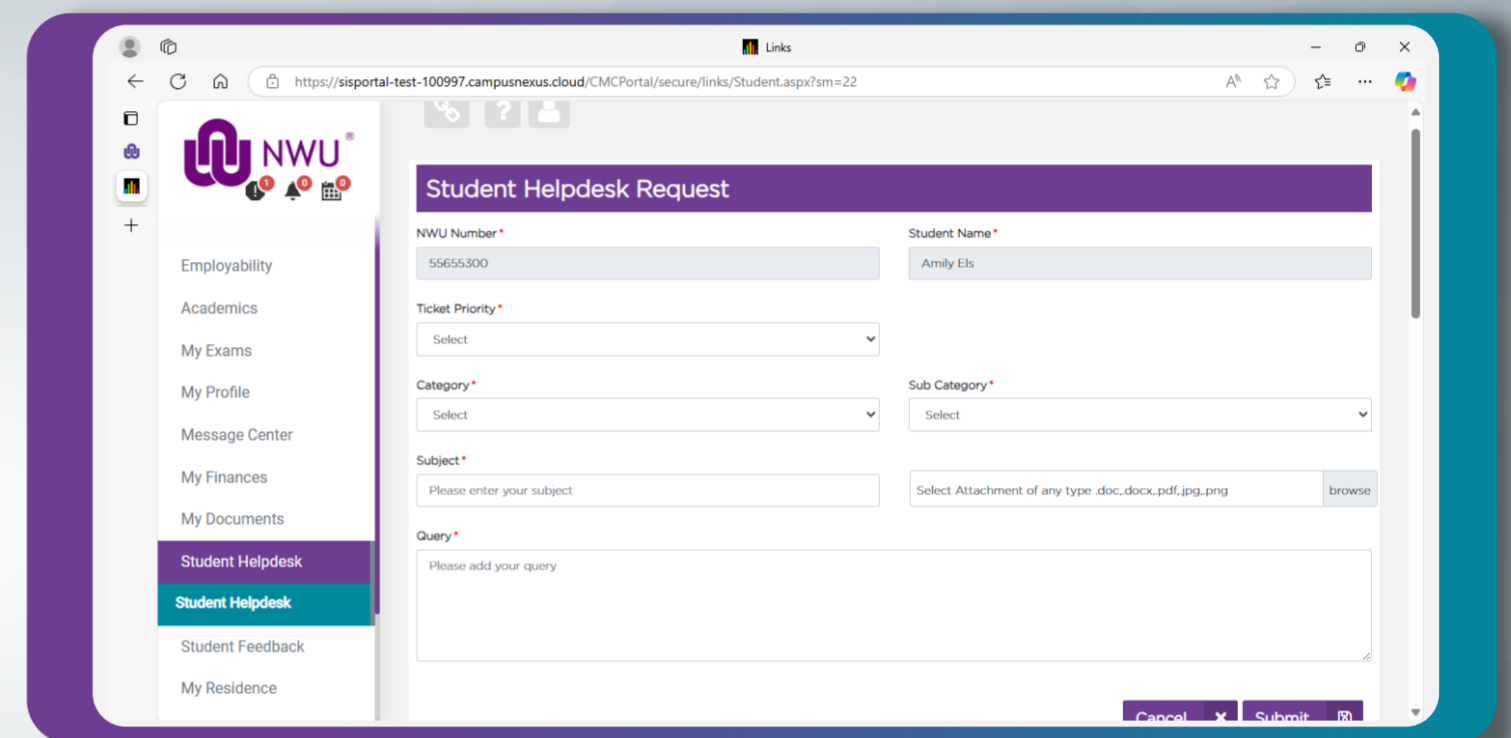
How do you log in to the Student Engagement Portal?

Once you've registered, you'll receive an email with your Student Engagement Portal login credentials. Use these credentials to log in to the Student Portal and other NWU systems.



Student Helpdesk

The Student Helpdesk is a tool designed to help you submit requests such as changing your qualifications or campus, or to report issues related to your academic or university life. The goal of the Student Helpdesk is to streamline communication and make it easier for you to get support on a range of university-related issues.



What can you do on the Student Engagement Portal?

The Student Engagement Portal is packed with features to help you stay on top of your academic and administrative needs:

Dashboard

The first time you enter the Student Engagement Portal, you will be taken to the Dashboard, which gives you a quick overview of your most important information, such as your preferred campus, qualification, enrolment status, and overall grade point average (GPA). It also provides a shortcut to your full profile.

Registration

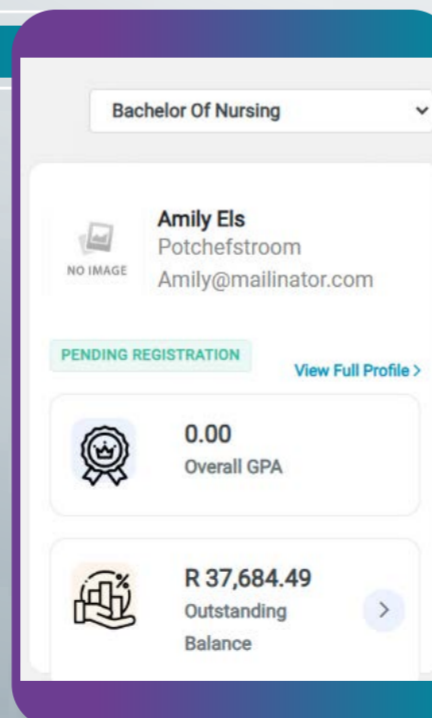
The first and most important step you can take on the portal is to register. Whether you are a first-time NWU student or a returning student, you will need to register for courses (modules) on the platform.
