For applications towards honours, fourth year in engineering, BTech or Advanced Diploma the bursary is restricted to the following areas:

- Biotechnology and related majors
- Chemistry
- Computer science
- Data science or ICT-related majors
- Engineering and related majors
- Health (biochemistry, microbiology, pharmaceutical sciences, biomedical sciences, etc.)
- Information systems
- Mathematics/applied maths/statistics
- Physics
