

FUNZA LUSHAKA BURSARY PROGRAMME INFORMATION

The Funza Lushaka Bursary Programme is a multi-year programme to promote teaching as a profession. Bursaries are available to enable eligible students to complete a teaching qualification in an area of National priority. Recipients of these bursaries will be required to work at a public school for the same number of years that they received the bursary.

Recipients of the bursary must apply online for the bursary every year. The recipient must also complete the placement information as required every year. The Provincial Education Departments (PED's) will place the graduate bursar in a suitable teaching post. If a particular PED does not have a suitable teaching post for the graduate bursar, the applicant may be placed in a PED that have a suitable post. Please note that bursars cannot choose the school in which they would like to be placed and placement cannot be deferred for any reason.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

- Applications for the Funza Lushaka bursary for **2024** will open on **01/10/2023**
- Please note that there are a limited number of new bursaries available for **2024**
- New applicants are advised to also pursue other funding opportunities such as NSFAS
- The outcome of the selection process will be available from the University not later than **30/04/2024**
- The bursary targets students who are younger than **30 years of age**

CLOSING DATES

- New applications close on **12/01/2024**; and
- Re-applications for Existing/Returning Bursars close on **30/11/2023**

To access, register and apply for the Funza Lushaka Bursary the following 9 easy steps should be followed:

NOTE: All first time applicants must be 30 years or younger to apply for Funza Lushaka Bursary.

1. Open the e-Gov portal at www.eservices.gov.za
2. Register by providing personal information
3. Login to the system using user name and password created when registering
4. On the e-Services Menu select Funza Lushaka Bursary Scheme
5. Enter the OTP received on the preferred channel
6. Accept the Terms and Conditions
7. On the dashboard menu click on the **2023** application button
8. Follow the steps to complete the required field with your information
9. Accept the declaration to confirm the information captured

Process for citizens to use the Funza Lushaka Information Management System

Step 1: e-Gov Portal

Open the e-Gov Portal:
www.eservices.gov.za



Step 2: Login or Register

Login with your previous login details, or Register a new account. Enter the OTP (One Time Pin) to complete the process



Step 3: Menu selection

On the e-Services menu, choose Funza Lusaka Bursary.



Step 4: T's and C's

Accept the Funza Lushaka terms and conditions to proceed.

Step 5: Apply

On the Dashboard menu, click on the Application button. Follow the steps to complete the required fields with your information.

Step 6: Declaration

Accept the declaration to confirm the information captured. Receive electronic feedback on the status of the application via email.
