



NOTICE TO ALL NWU CONTACT STUDENTS REGARDING SECOND SEMESTER EXAMINATIONS

First Opportunity Examination commences on 17 October until 08 November 2024
Second Opportunity Examination commences on 11 November until 22 November 2024

A levy of R270 per module applies if a student makes use of the second opportunity.

1 IDENTIFICATION

- Students should report to their exam venues within **20 minutes** before the commencement of the assessment.
- Students must present valid student cards when they enter an exam venue. Please note that an invigilator may request a student to collect a Proof of Registration if the student number is not legible or the invigilator cannot identify the student by means of the photo on the student card.
- If students do not have their student cards with them, they will have to present a Proof of Registration. They can request a Proof of Registration from Student Records Office at the relevant NWU Campus.
- The date on the Proof of Registration must be the same as the assessment/examination date of the relevant module.
- A Proof of Registration must be presented together with a valid ID document or valid driver's license.
- No extra time will be allowed if students must collect a Proof of Registration, ID-document, or driver's license.
- Students who are late, for a valid reason, will not be allowed to enter the exam venue later than 30 minutes after the commencement of the relevant assessment. In such instances **NO EXTRA** time will be granted. Students who arrive late will only be allowed into the venue once all announcements have been made.

2 ASSESSMENT VENUE RULES

- Students may only take water into the exam venue .
- Due to the increasing incidents of theft, we advise students not to bring their bags to the a exam venues. If students should bring their bags, it is at their own risk.
- Students may not borrow any item from other students.
- If an invigilator notices a cell phone or any electronic device, e.g., tablet, smart watch in a student's possession, this will be deemed as an exam infringement.
- **NB CELLPHONES OR ANY OTHER ELECTRONIC DEVICES ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE ASSESSMENT VENUE UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED ON THE QUESTION PAPER**
- **ALL INSTRUCTIONS ON THE ANSWER SCRIPT MUST BE ADHERED TO BY STUDENTS**
