An NSFAS student is a student who has applied for and received approval for financial support from the National Student Financial Aid Scheme (NSFAS) to pursue their university studies in 2024.

Cash-paying Students

Students who pay for their study fees "out-of-pocket" and do not have an external bursary or loan to fund their studies.

Step 1

Admission to the NWU.

Step 3

Register via the NWU Registration Portal.

Step (2)

Pay the minimum payable amount(s) as indicated in Fees Payable and Financial Rules Booklet.

Step 4 Visit the <u>First-year Students 2024 website</u>.

NB: Your minimum payable amount must be paid 48 hours before you register!
