

**NOTICE TO THE NWU POTCHEFSTROOM CAMPUS STUDENT COMMUNITY ON THE FILLING OF A VACANCY IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH 18 OF THE INSTITUTIONAL RULES ON STUDENT GOVERNANCE**

<b>Date:</b>	10 December 2025

1. On 28 November 2025 the NWU student community was informed that the membership of the Potchefstroom Campus (PC) SCC: Chairperson, as well as the SRC: Secretary-General, terminated in accordance with paragraph 17.1 of the IRSG.
2. The process towards the filling of the vacancy commenced thereafter, done in accordance with paragraph 18.1.1.i of the IRSG.
3. The runner-up candidate for the affected SCC portfolio, as published on the [preliminary election outcome](#), was requested to accept or decline the position, with the candidate **declining** the position.
4. **Guided by paragraph 18.1.1.ii of the IRSG, the ISEC resolved on 08 December 2025 to declare the position of PC-SCC: Chairperson vacant:**
  - ii. If only one candidate had contested the affected portfolio, or if no other candidate is available to fill the vacancy, the position is declared vacant and the SCC must resolve by a two-thirds majority of the remaining members to add the functions of the vacated portfolio(s) to the responsibilities of other members of the SCC, which may be revised from time to time to ensure effective workload distribution.
5. The PC-SCC is now required to give effect to the provisions of paragraph 18.1.1.ii of the IRSG by distributing the functions of the vacated portfolio to remaining SCC member(s), thereafter informing the student community and relevant University functionaries of the outcome.
