## Why are your final Grade 11 results so important?

Putting effort into your Grade 11 studies is crucial as it will significantly ease the challenges you may face in matric. Your Grade 11 results are a testament to your dedication, perseverance, and academic ability. These qualities are highly valued and play a key role in securing your place at the University.

At North-West University (NWU), conditional acceptance is granted based on your final Grade 11 results. This means that if you perform well and meet the required standards, you are one step closer to starting your journey at NWU. However, it's important that you maintain or exceed these results in your Grade 12 year to ensure that you receive your final acceptance offer.

By putting in the necessary effort now, you will be laying a strong foundation for your academic future. Not only will you make your matric year more manageable, but you will also increase your chances of starting your university education at NWU on the right foot. Remember, the hard work and determination you show today will open doors to future opportunities and success.



## What are the requirements for degree studies?

- Obtain a National Senior Certificate (NSC) issued by Umalusi, which also indicates that you have fulfilled the requirements for a bachelor's degree.
- The minimum requirements for admission to degree studies are an NSC with a minimum of **50% in four 20-credit NSC subjects**.
- The APS is calculated from six subjects, excluding Life Orientation.
- Subject-specific requirements per faculty, which include the language of learning and teaching at 50%.

## What is an APS?

Ever wondered how universities decide whether you're accepted or not? It's all about the APS (Admission Point Score)! This scoring system is a tool to see if you qualify for your chosen qualification. Each course has its own unique APS!

### How do I calculate my APS?

A maximum of six (6) subjects are used to determine your APS. Life Orientation is not taken into account when calculating your APS.

NSC Level	APS Score
8 = 90-100%	8
7 = 80-89%	7
6 = 70-79%	6
5 = 60-69%	5
4 = 50-59%	4
3 = 40-49%	3
2 = 30-39%	2
1 = 0-29%	1

### Example

Kagiso is in Grade 11 and wants to study Consumer Studies. For a Bachelor of Consumer Studies, he needs a level 4 in Physical OR Life Sciences, a level 6 in Mathematical Literacy and an APS of 24. For his mid-year exams, he achieved:

- Setswana = 72 = 6
- English = 77 = 6
- History = 85% = 7
- Mathematical Literacy = 82% = 7
- Life Sciences = 69% = 5
- Physical Sciences = 76% = 6

Kagiso has an APS of 37. He meets the requirements, so he needs to maintain his marks for these final Grade 11 results.

### Example

Eliské wants to study Chemical Engineering. The requirements for a degree in Chemical Engineering is a level 5 in home language or First Additional Language, a level 6 in Mathematics and Physical Sciences, and an APS of 34. She achieved the following in her mid-year exams:

- Afrikaans = 67% = 5
- English = 77 = 6
- Information Technology = 65% = 5
- Mathematics = 83% = 7
- Life Sciences = 69% = 5
- Physical Sciences = 76% = 6

Eliské has an APS of 34 and meets the requirements. She needs to maintain her marks for the final Grade 11 results.

## Non-South African school systems



If you attend or attended a private or international school, you will need to convert your grades to calculate your APS. NWU has compiled a conversion table for you to use. To access the table, visit: <https://www.nwu.ac.za/content/cambridge-admission-international-students>

The **Cambridge International curriculum** is the most widely used international examination. The Cambridge **IGCSE qualification** is equivalent to a South African **Grade 11** and the Cambridge **AS Levels** are equivalent to a South African **Grade 12**.

Depending on which level of the Cambridge system you complete, you'll receive different scores.

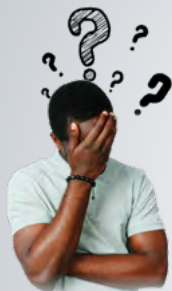
- **O/IGCSE levels** get the lowest scores, starting at 5.
- **AS levels**, which are equivalent to the South African matric where a grade above 90% gets an 8 and 80% and above gets a 7, etc.
- **A level**, which is equivalent to the first year at university, is the highest with a grade A scoring APS = 10.
- Calculate APS with **six (6) subjects**. Your **APS** is calculated on the basis of the **highest level** passed.

### Academic Merit Bursary

All full-time first, second and third-year students will automatically qualify for this bursary if they have completed their degree within the relevant time frame, e.g. completing a 3-year degree within 3 years. You must meet specific academic requirements to qualify. Part-time students must apply and qualify for half of the allocation.

### Arts and Culture Bursary

Students qualify on the basis of their achievements in arts and culture from Grade 8-12.

To apply, visit: <https://bit.ly/2WlpRcP>. The Department of Arts and Culture will assess your application. Senior students qualify based on participation in cultural activities at the University, e.g. NWU Choir, Symphony Orchestra and others.



### Support Bursary

The NWU offers bursaries to prospective students with physical disabilities or students who have come from an orphanage or foster care system. The student must have been admitted to the University before applying and need only apply once. Please ensure that all the necessary documents are attached to the application form.

### Family Discount

Families with two or more students enrolled at NWU at the same time can apply for this bursary and will receive a percentage discount on tuition fees depending on whether you are the second, third, or fourth family member. One student must apply each year and it is not awarded automatically.

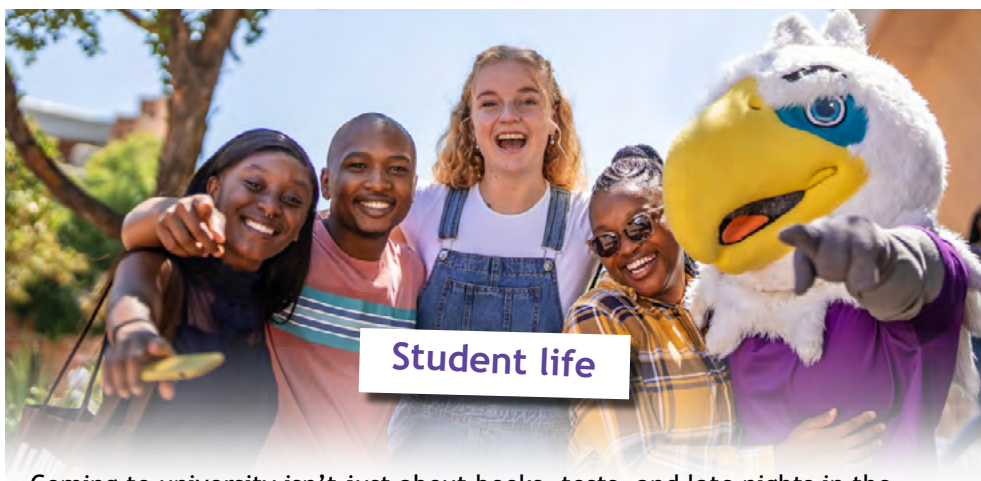
## Leadership Bursary

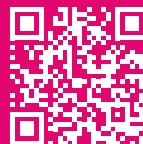

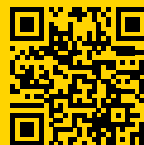
